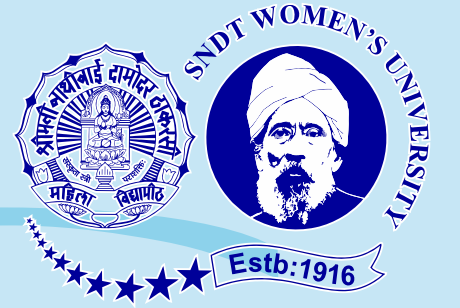

या महिन्यातील संपादकीय लिखाणातून काहीतरी वेगळं मांडण्याचा प्रयत्न करणार आहे. ऑक्टोबर महिन्यात जागतिक मानसिक आरोग्य दिन हा १० ऑक्टोबर रोजी सर्वत्र साजरा केला जातो. तसेच ३१ ऑक्टोबर हा राष्ट्रीय एकता दिवस म्हणून साजरा केला जातो. एस. एन. डी. टी महिला विद्यापीठात विविध उपक्रमाद्वारे जागतिक मानसिक आरोग्य दिन साजरा करण्यात आला.

जागतिक मानसिक आरोग्य दिन साजरा करण्यामागे मानसिक आरोग्याविषयी माहिती समाजात सर्वत्र पोहोचावी हा मुख्य हेतू आहे. महाराष्ट्र हि संतांची भूमी अनेक संतांनी आपल्या मनाची मशागत कशी करावी हे अत्यंत स्पष्टपणे मांडले आहे. जगतगुरु संतश्रेष्ठ तुकाराम महाराजांनी 'तुका म्हणे होय मनाशी संवाद' या ओवीतून प्रत्येक व्यक्तीने आपला स्वतःशी संवाद साधणे किती गरजेचे आहे हे अधोरेखित केले आहे.

आजकालच्या धावपळीच्या जगात आणि तंत्रज्ञानाच्या युगात स्व संवाद, आपसातील संवाद अत्यंत कमी झाला आहे. अनेकदा मनातला साचलेपण वाढत जाऊन त्याचा उद्रेक होतो आणि कधी कधी टोकाची भूमिका घेतली जाते. शारीरिक आरोग्यासोबत मानसिक आरोग्य जपणे हे तितकेच गरजेचे ठरते. आपल्याकडे मानसिक आजारासाठी मानसोपचार तज्ञ किंवा समुपदेशकाकडे जाणे आजही समाजमान्य नाही. त्यामुळे उपचाराअभावी मानसिक आजाराची तीव्रता वाढत जाते. मुळात केवळ १० ऑक्टोबर रोजी केवळ एक दिवसासाठी मानसिक आरोग्याविषयी मंथन मर्यादित न ठेवता निकोप मानसिक आरोग्य हि संकल्पना रोजच्या जगण्यातील भाग बनली पाहिजे.

सध्याच्या काळात संवाद कमी झाल्यामुळे एकमेकांचे मनापासून कौतुक करणे हे जरा दुर्मिळच झाले आहे. विद्यापीठस्तरावर विद्यार्थ्यांनी केलेले सामाजिक उपक्रम असतील, तसेच त्यांनी विविध स्पर्धेत मिळविलेल्या यशाचे शिक्षक, पालक यांनी वेळोवेळी कौतुक केले पाहिजे त्यामुळे विद्यार्थ्यांचे मनोबल वाढीस लागते. अधिकारी वर्गाने आपल्या कर्मचाऱ्यांकरिता आनंददायी असे कामकाजाचे वातावरण निर्मिती केली पाहिजे त्यातूनच एखाद्या संस्थेची कार्यसंस्कृती वाढीस लागते. आज टाटा कंपनी त्यांच्या कार्यसंस्कृतीसाठी सर्वदूर ओळखली जाते.

आपले सोबतचे सहकारी तसेच कर्मचारी यांच्यातील कलागुणांना वाव कसा मिळेल त्यासाठी प्रयत्नशील असणे त्यांना योग्य ते व्यासपीठ मिळवून देणे हे खऱ्या अर्थाने मनुष्य विकासाची नांदी म्हणता येईल. अशा सातत्यपूर्ण प्रयत्नांनी आपल्या आजूबाजूला न चमकलेल्या ताऱ्यांची गोष्ट तयार होऊन खऱ्या अर्थाने ते स्वयं प्रकाशित होतील यात काहीच शंका नाही. त्यासाठी गरज आहे मानसिक आरोग्याच्या क्षेत्रात सातत्यपूर्ण आणि सर्वसमावेशक कार्य करण्याची.

३१ ऑक्टोबर हा राष्ट्रीय एकता दिवस म्हणून सर्वत्र साजरा केला जातो. आपल्या सर्वांना लहानपणी शाळेत सामूहिकरित्या म्हणलेली प्रतिज्ञा आठवत असेलच. राष्ट्रीय ऐक्याचे बाळकडू हे शालेय जीवनातून मिळते. पुढे नागरिकशास्त्र हा विषय अभ्यासक्रमात येतो केवळ २० मार्चासाठी आणि त्या पुस्तकाची पानेही २० त्यामुळे अनेकदा केवळ २० मार्चाचा विषय इतक्याच परिघात हा विषय पहिला जातो.

Brief History of L.T. COLLEGE OF NURSING

Leelabai Thackersey College of Nursing is a constituent college of SNDT Women's University, established in 1952 with a motto "Service through excellence in nursing education" has been a leading institution in the field of nursing since last 70 years. L.T. College started as a department of nursing, and then rose to a full-fledged college in 1964 recognized by Maharashtra Nursing Council in 1965 and Indian Nursing Council in 1969. It offers 4 year under graduate course earning a B.Sc. Nursing degree, 2yr Post graduate Nursing Programme culminating in to Masters in Nursing (1976) with specialization in the field of Cardio thoracic nursing, Critical Care Nursing, Mental Health Nursing, Pediatric Nursing, Obstetric & Gynecological Nursing, Community health Nursing, and Ph.D. in Nursing (1993). It is the first College to offer baccalaureate and Master in Nursing in the state of Maharashtra, only college which conducted Neonatal Nursing course of one year duration. The college began with merely four students and increased its strength to 50 students enrolled every year for B.Sc. Nursing and 15 for Master's Program. The college focuses on developing Proficient Nurses and Nursing leaders who will bring constant change in nursing through Evidence Based Clinical Practice. It is a recognized institution internationally contributing Nursing leader for Health care industry at State, National and International level. The College has set a bench mark in the field of nursing in the country from last 70 years.

The students who join this institution after completing 12th Science are required to have a minimum score of 50% for open and 45% for students from reserve category. The students receive rich clinical experience in BMC - Sion /K.E.M/Nair /Kasturba Hospital, Government- J.J. Hospital, TATA Hospital, Wadia Group of hospital and well know private hospitals like Hinduja, Saifee Hospital.

The Students of this College have job opportunities in India and abroad and hold positions like Staff Nurse, Ward/ Head nurse, Assist.. Nursing Superintendent, Nursing Superintendent, Director of Nursing service, Clinical nurse specialist, nurse researcher, nurse practitioner, community health nurse/ Public health nurse... The alumni College has received many awards and is proud that two of its alumni received the highest award that is Florence Nightingale from the President of India. Today its alumni head many of the major Private and B.M.C hospitals in the capacity of Matron, Director of Nursing service, Assistant director of health services Government of Maharashtra. Abroad they hold position for quality control, in field of Education, are Nurse Practitioners having their own clinics and hold positions in multinational health care organization as vice presidents and CEO's. The faculty strives to constantly keep themselves and the alumni updated with latest trends in nursing and health care. The college organizes conferences, workshop and skill based programs on a regular bases for nurses from various institutions. Leelabai Thackersey College of Nursing actively contributes to educating the public on health issues. 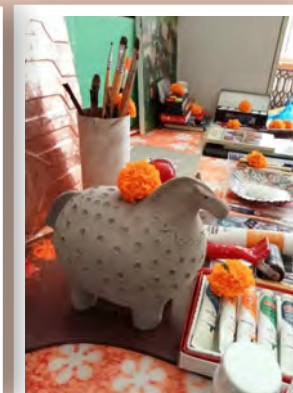
B.V.A. and M.V.A. Department of Drawing and Painting, Mumbai "DUSSEHRA- CELEBRATION"

SNDT Women's University signs MoU with BMCC New York at Raj Bhavan

An agreement of academic collaboration between SNDT Women's University, 106-year old First Women's University of India and the Borough of Manhattan Community College (BMCC), the largest Community College under the City University of New York (CUNY) was signed in presence of Maharashtra Governor and Chancellor of universities Bhagat Singh Koshyari at Raj Bhavan Mumbai. A Conclave on "Internationalisation of Higher Education: Opportunities and Challenges" was also held on the occasion.

President of the BMCC (Borough of Manhattan Community College) - CUNY Dr Anthony Munroe and Vice Chancellor of SNDT Women's University Prof. Ujwala Chakradeo signed the Statement of Shared Interest in presence of the Governor.

Speaking on the occasion, the Governor said that we live in an era of collaboration and cooperation and not confrontation. This collaboration will bring new light in students' work-life. Complimenting the SNDT Women's University and the BMCC Community College for embarking on a partnership for student and faculty exchange, the Governor said the collaboration will produce good results for both the sides within the next few years. He mentioned that goodwill of both the organisations will benefit each other.

President of the BMCC, CUNY, New York Dr Anthony Munroe said the BMCC is the largest community college in the US, offering affordable education to students from 140 different countries. Stating that 60 per cent of the BMCC students were women, he felt that partnership with SNDT Women's University will prove to be mutually beneficial. He said the fees charged by the College is one-sixth of private colleges.

He mentioned that the BMCC is rated among the top 5 Community Colleges in the United States, having collaboration with best known financial institutions such as Goldman Sach, Zurich, Citi Bank, Moody's and others. He said students of the Colleges can pursue further higher education in the best Ivy league institutions such as New York, Columbia, Harvard, Yale, Starnford, UC Berkeley and MIT.

Vice Chancellor of SNDT Women's University Dr. Ujwala Chakradeo said the MoU is being signed right at a time when India is ready to implement the National Education Policy 2020. Dr. Chakradeo highlighted that both the institutions offer diverse courses opening many avenues of academic collaboration for the students of both the countries. She expressed the hope that girls from India will get the best of higher education opportunities through the partnership with BMCC. Stating that Skill education is the forte of the SNDT Women's University, she further said that the areas of collaboration with BMCC such as internship, joint degrees, entrepreneurship etc. have been identified and will be acted upon. She hopes that many students from both the universities will be able to visit and work with each other.

Shri. Santosh Kumar, Secretary to Governor, Maharashtra; Shri. Rakesh Naithani, Special Secretary to the Governor and Officer on Special Duty; Ms. Sita Raiter, Dy Cultural Attaché from the US Consulate General, Mumbai and Mr. Sanjay Ramdath, Director and Acting Vice President of Enrollment Management, BMCC graced the occasion. Ms. Sita assured all support needed for the future collaboration and student exchange. Prof Ruby Ojha, Pro Vice Chancellor of SNDTWU, Registrar Dr Vilas Nandavadekar, Dr Nitin Wani of International Cell, Deans, Heads of various departments and Principals of autonomous and affiliated Colleges under SNDTWU were present.

The conclave to discuss mutual collaboration opportunities continued in the next session. About 35 academic leaders from SNDT Women's University shared unique features of their departments and colleges, strengths of their programmes and expressed possible avenues of collaboration. The session concluded with the presentation by Mr. Sanjay Ramdath about BMCC.

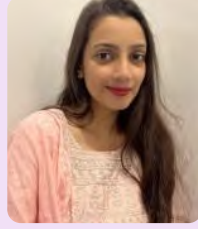
