The Department of Drawing and Painting was started in 1984 with Prof. Chafekar and Prof. Aphale. Further it was nurtured by renowned artist, scholar Dr. Bhaiyya Saheb Onkar. After him Shri. Mukund Kelkar headed the department along with Dr. Malati Agte. Mukund Kelkar was a stylistic painter and mural artist. Dr. Malati Agte was the first Ph.D. student of the department. The Department of Drawing and painting was the only department which was offering Ph.D. in painting in Maharashtra. Until 2008 the Department was offering M.A. degree in Art and Painting. As per UGC guidelines Department started MVA (Masters of Visual Arts) under the headship of Dr. Anita Satsangi in 2008.
