Programmes - Duration and Outcomes

A) MASTER OF EDUCATION (M.Ed.)

Two years (4 Semesters) Full-time on-campus Masters Degree Programme. M.Ed. Program is a set of theory courses and practical work that are linked together meaningfully aiming at achieving excellence and competence in pedagogic practices and enabling the student teacher to become an efficient and effective school teacher. The said program will end in awarding a degree 'Master of Education'.

Eligibility: a. Candidates seeking admission to the M.Ed. programme should have obtained at least 50% marks or an equivalent grade in the following programmes:

- (i) B.Ed.
- (ii) B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed.
- (ii) B.El.Ed.

(iii) D.El.Ed.with an Undergraduate degree (with 50% marks in each)

b. Pass in CET of Government of Maharashtra

Medium of Instruction: The medium of instruction for the M. Ed. Course will be Marathi or English provided the Department concerned can make arrangements and is permitted to do so by the University.

Intake: 50

Program Outcome:

- To acquire advanced knowledge about philosophy, sociology and psychology of education.
- Develop knowledge and understanding of the process of educational research and skill in conducting research in the field of education.
- Explore, reflect on and develop one's own teaching practice.
- Develop insight into one's knowledge of and update oneself about one's academic discipline or other areas of curriculum.
- Prepare for other roles professionally linked to education/teaching, such as teacher education, curriculum development or counseling.

Future Career Prospects: Education field is changing rapidly. Quality teacher educators, consultant and research assistants can play a major role in enhancing the quality of education.

B) MASTER OF ARTS (EDUCATION)

Two years (4 Semesters) Full-time on-campus Masters Degree Programme

Eligibility: Women candidates with Bachelor's degree in any discipline, with or without a degree in education from a recognized University.

Admission Procedure: Eligible candidates need to register online on SNTD portal for admission. Selection of the candidate is done on the merit basis.

Medium of Instruction: English

Intake: 20

Programme Outcomes: To enable the students to-

- Apply educational theory in practice
- Undertake research in the field of Education.
- Get familiar with functioning of various organizations working in the field of education Apply the theory to practical situations.

Future Career Prospects: Work as teacher trainer in NGO's, work in schools, Curriculum developer, Teacher at different levels of education.

C) Ph.D. in EDUCATION

Minimum 3 years (6 Semesters) Max.5 Year (10 Semester)

Eligibility: Women candidates with master's degree in education, with 55 % of marks and need to qualify the PET exam.

Candidates with NET / SET/ M. Phil in education are exempted from the PET exam.

Admission Procedure: Application form for the Ph.D. programme is available on the official website of the University and applicants will be required to pay the prescribed application fee online at the time of submission of the form, to the University.

Programme Outcomes : To enable a scholar to

- Acquire broad and deep expertise, including knowledge and skills, across subfields of Education.
- Ability to engage with, plan, and conduct interdisciplinary research.
- Apply knowledge and skills to promote inquiry, discover solutions, generate new ideas, and communicate their research.

Future Career Prospects: Successful candidates can work as Principal, Head and educational consultant for NGOs.

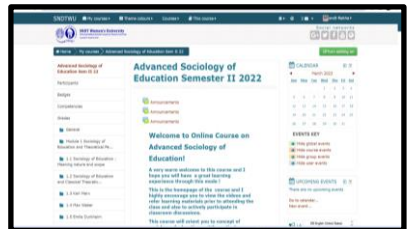
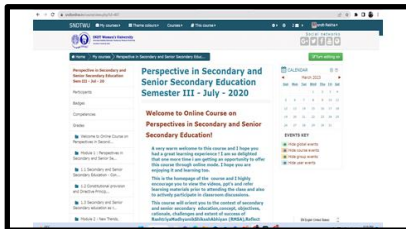
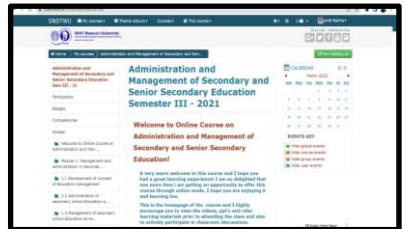
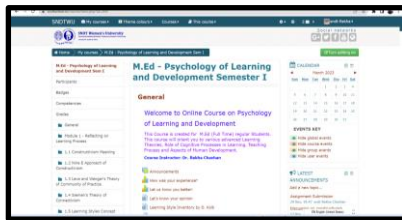
Best Practices

There have been some indirect indicators of employability of educational personnel in general, and teachers and heads of schools in particular, presuming employability skills impact on-the-job effectiveness. Therefore, it should be possible to construct a paradigm of employability skills of educational personnel, especially teachers that would enable him/her to successfully manage change, and hence, improve quality of education. With respect to teachers, content knowledge and teacher effectiveness may be hypothetically related to teacher employability.

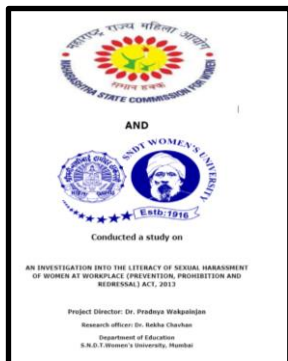
This study was undertaken to explore the third dimension of the teacher employability, namely the soft skills that have been termed as 'employability' per se by the research Literature.

A Study of Gender Sensitivity of Student Teachers in relation to some demographic variables

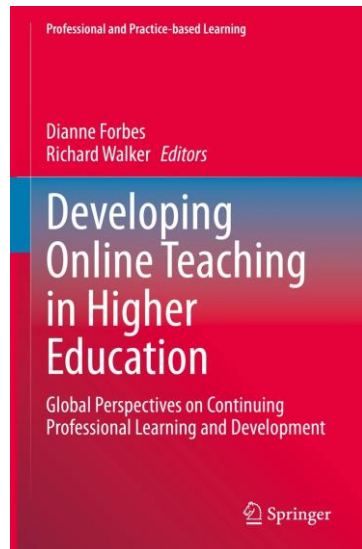
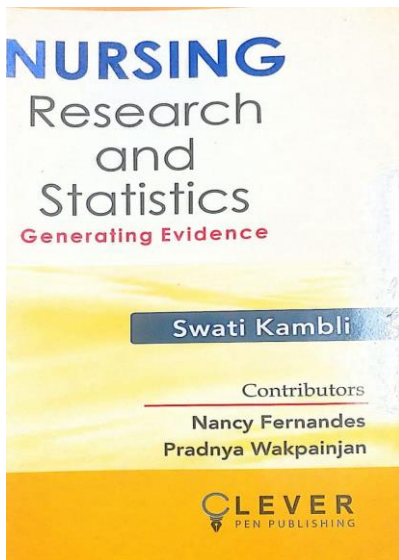

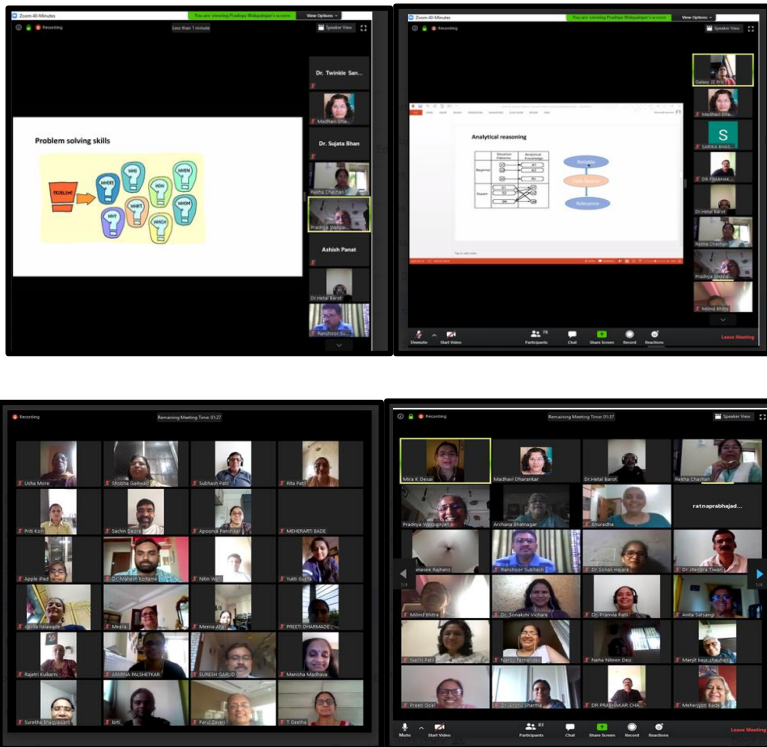
1. Webinar on Learning objectives and learning outcomes
